Giving Vocal Point a run for their money, Noteworthy contains nine female members whose voices deliver a power packed concert that combines vocal percussion, humor and a tight harmony style that's all their own. Noteworthy has appeared on NBC's hit television show, "The Sing-Off," and have also been crowned the International Championship of Collegiate A capelle (ICCA) champions in 2007.

Noteworthy is currently under the direction of former Vocal Point member Keith Evans and they are looking for the top 9 female singers at BYU. "Being a part of Noteworthy's first year as an official BYU performing ensemble will be historic; the 9 ladies selected will be handed an enormous challenge and opportunity to lay the foundation for years and decades to come. Never since their founding has there been a more thrilling time to be in this amazing group" said Evans.

When asked how Noteworthy influenced her life, Amy Whitcomb, Noteworthy Alumni (also seen on NBC's "The Voice" and 2 seasons of NBC's "The Sing Off".) said, "I can't even count the ways. Every aspect of my life has been affected by Noteworthy. Musically I've grown leaps and bounds by being in Noteworthy, but I also learned a lot about life - How to work as part of a team, how to communicate, how to work on relationships, and it's also helped my confidence so much.
