- Made up of 32 dancers and five student technicians. Leaders include an artistic director, tour manager, technical director, trainer, and chaperones.
- Since 1971, the company has performed in 36 different countries and throughout the U.S.
- The current U.S. National Champion team in formation dance, the group also competes every three years in the prestigious British Ballroom Dance Championships in Blackpool, England, where they have won first place consistently for many years.
