Type of Performance

Both the lavish costumes and the intricate choreography are authentic representations of the showcase cultures.

The group is made up of approximately 30 performers, and 7 student technicians. Leaders include an artistic director, technical director, tour manager, and chaperones.

History

The Living Legends first performed in 1971, and since that time the group has performed the world over.

Most recent tours include: Central America, visiting Guatemala, Honduras, and Nicaragua in spring 2013, Argentina, Uruguay, and Paraguay in May 2009, and China in May 2010. Chile in 2008, USA and Canada in 2007, Alaska, Germany and Austria in 2006, and Mexico in 2005.
