- Noteworthy is Brigham Young University's premiere female a cappella ensemble.
- Noteworthy consists of nine members who exhibit a high level of musicianship, stage presence, and creativity. Members take radio hits and deliver new renditions, mimicking complex instrumentation with only their voices.
- Noteworthy's varied repertoire includes rock, pop, country, jazz, musical theatre, R&B, spiritual, and other musical styles so as to appeal to audiences of all backgrounds.
- Current director Keith Evans performed with male a cappella group Vocal Point while he was a student at BYU. Evans is the assistant director of ReMix Vocal Academy, a BYU a cappella summer camp, and is currently a song-writer and lyricist for ARORA Productions.
- Noteworthy was invited by NBC to be one of eight groups featured on the debut season of the hit TV show *The Sing-Off*.
- Noteworthy's "Amazing Grace (My Chains Are Gone)" music video went viral with over three million views in two weeks after its release in October 2015. "Amazing Grace" also spent a week on iTunes's Top 10 Christian and Gospel songs chart.
- In 2007, Noteworthy won first place in the International Championship of Collegiate A cappella, held at the Lincoln Center in New York City.
- Founded in 2003 by BYU alumni Esther Yoder, Noteworthy only recently became an official BYU performing group (in fall 2014).
- Noteworthy has released four albums to date, with another in the making.
- Noteworthy is managed by Performing Arts Management at Brigham Young University in Provo, Utah. BYU is one of America's largest private universities, with approximately 30,000 students from about 110 countries. BYU was founded in 1875 by The Church of Jesus Christ of Latter-day Saints. The university offers about 180 bachelor's degrees, more than 60 master's degrees, and some 25 doctoral degrees, including a juris doctor. BYU's faculty numbers about 1,600.
