Directing the voices of 190 hand-picked male vocalists of Brigham Young University Men's Chorus is conductor Rosalind Hall. As the largest and one of the most popular collegiate male choirs in the United States, Men's Chorus delivers a powerful performance with polished harmonies and full range of male voices. Rosalind Hall brings experience, training, and a love of music to the choir. Hall's love of music extends from the roots of her heritage. As a native of Wales in Great Britain, Hall comes from a land with one of the strongest choral traditions in the world. Hall is a graduate of the Royal Academy of Music in London and a former student of various choral programs at the London College of Music, Edinburgh University, and London University. Hall came to the United States to continue her studies at Brigham Young University, earning a master's degree and the conductor of both Men's Chorus and the BYU Concert Choir. Prior to conducting Men's Chorus, Hall was esteemed as the Director of Choral Activities and Music Department Chair at the Waterford School in Sandy, Utah.

Hall joined the BYU faculty in September 1999 to fill a vacancy left when previous Men's Chorus conductor Mack Wilberg accepted a position as an associate director of the Mormon Tabernacle Choir in May 1999. Continuing the Men's Chorus legacy of excellence, Hall brings a new, yet equally impressive caliber to the choir. Programs continue to feature a strong and dynamic repertoire ranging from medieval chant to fully choreographed production numbers, with multi-talented singers also performing as instrumentalists and dancers.
