

## **Synthesis**

The following information outlines the technical requirements of Synthesis. Please reach out to Sam Herrera wia sam.herrera byu.edu with any questions.

**Load-in:** Please have the required set-up completed when we arrive, as specified in the

attached diagram.

**Sound:** Synthesis travels with a full sound system, but may require access to house

speakers from our mixing console. When we arrive, please have someone

available who can accommodate this.

**Power:** We require two 20 amp power circuits, one downstage center and one upstage.

**Lighting:** Lighting should allow all 20 musicians to be visible to the audience.

**Piano:** A recently tuned grand or baby grand piano is preferable. If neither is available,

we will bring our own electric piano.

Stage: The stage should be a minimum of 30' wide by 24' deep (9.1m x 7.3m) and large

enough to accommodate the setup shown on the diagram below. Risers are needed for the brass section (16' wide x 12' deep x 16" tall or 4.9m x 3.7m x

0.4m).

We travel with our own music stands, but would prefer seven more if they are

available. We need 20 chairs, arranged according to the diagram.

**Load-out:** A minimum of one hour for strike and load-out time is required.
