ACTIVITY	SET UP	LENGTH	REQUIREMENTS	NOTES
School Lecture/ Demonstration		30 minutes		Content: Talk about the history of ballet, costumes and differences in technique between men and women; perform excerpts from the performance; involve the children by bringing them up to help demonstrate' introduce all the dancers and the children can ask questions.
School/ Community Outreach		45-60 minutes		Content: Simple warm up class with ballet steps; we divide the participants into groups and a BYU student teaches the participants a section or dance from our performance; after learning the different excerpts, each group performs for the other groups.
Ballet Master Class		90 minutes		Content: Either the artistic director or one of the BYU students teaches a ballet technique master class--this is either at the theater if we have time on stage or at a local dance studio.
