- The Brigham Young University Singers is an exciting choir with impressive voices and a wide range of styles. The group performs pieces from nearly every musical genre as well as many original works written or arranged for the choir.
- The BYU Singers have performed in some of the most prestigious concert halls in the world, including Carnegie Hall in New York City, the Kennedy Center in Washington, D.C., the Sydney Opera House and Town Hall, the Kapella in St. Petersburg, the Musik Verein in Vienna, and the Walt Disney Concert Hall in Los Angeles.
- The choir most recently completed an extended tour throughout China in April and May 2015. In a 21-day period the group performed in nine different cities and worked with numerous university and community choirs, in workshops and giving a number of joint performances.
- The BYU Singers in 2014 toured the Pacific Northwest of the United States. The choir visited 10 cities throughout Idaho, Washington, and Oregon. Prior to that the group visited and performed in Wales and England in 2012.
- The BYU Singers have traveled throughout the United States and to 27 countries including Russia, Germany, Switzerland, Italy, England, Egypt, Australia, Ghana, Ireland, and China.
- In May, 2009, the Singers participated in the prestigious Cork International Choral Festival in Ireland. The group were awarded 2nd place in the competition as well as the PEACE trophy which is given to the audience's favorite choir. Following the festival, the group performed in other Irish cities and in central England and Wales.
- Many members of the choir are fine instrumentalists in addition to being talented singers. Dr. Andrew Crane, the group's artistic director, regularly incorporates choir members' instrumental abilities in the pieces performed by the choir.
- Director of the choir, Dr. Andrew Crane, is a graduate of BYU, and has returned to BYU from North Carolina to take the helm of this performing group beginning this school year.
- The BYU Singers originates in the School of Music of the College of Fine Arts & Communications at Brigham Young University in Provo, Utah. BYU is one of the nation's largest private universities with an enrollment of more than 30,000 students from all parts of the United States and 100 foreign countries.
