- Brigham Young University Singers is an exciting choral ensemble that performs music from a variety of periods and styles. From a Renaissance motet to an African-American spiritual, the group performs pieces from nearly every musical genre as well as many original works written or arranged for the choir.
- BYU Singers has performed in some of the most prestigious concert halls in the world, including Carnegie Hall in New York City; the Kennedy Center in Washington, D.C.; the Sydney Opera House and Town Hall in Sydney, Australia; the Kapella in St. Petersburg; the Musikverein in Vienna; and the Walt Disney Concert Hall in Los Angeles.
- The choral ensemble will take their impressive talents to Vietnam and Indonesia in May 2018.
- BYU Singers will be featured at the 2017 Biennial Conference of The National Collegiate Choral Organization (NCCO) in Baton Rouge, Louisiana. In 2006, they sang at the inaugural conference for the NCCO.
- The choir most recently completed a USA tour in Arizona in 2016 and an extended tour to China in the spring of 2015. In a 21-day period, the group performed in nine different cities and worked with numerous universities and community choirs giving workshops and collaborating in joint performances throughout China.
- BYU Singers has traveled within the United States and to 27 countries including Russia, Germany, Switzerland, Italy, England, Egypt, Australia, Ghana, Ireland, and South Africa.
- In 2009, the choir participated in the Cork International Choral Festival in Ireland, where they received the Audience Favorite Award, sponsored by the P.E.A.C.E. organization. Following the festival, the group performed in other cities in Ireland and in central England and Wales.
- The choir, by invitation, has performed three separate concerts with the Israeli Chamber Orchestra in Israel.
- Also by invitation, BYU Singers has performed numerous times at regional and national conferences of the American Choral Directors Association.
- The group was one of two choirs chosen to represent the United States at the Fourth World Symposium on Choral Music in Sydney, Australia, and also represented the U.S. by singing at the 2002 Winter Olympics in Salt Lake City.
- Director of the choir, Dr. Andrew Crane, is a graduate of BYU and took the helm of this performing group at the start of the 2015 season. Dr. Crane is the first new BYU Singers director in over 31 years. Choirs under his direction have appeared by invitation at multiple conferences of the American Choral Directors Association and National Association for Music Education and have won top prizes in international competitions.
