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Lodging

Vocal Point must be lodged in established hotel chains (ie. Marriott, Sheraton, Hyatt, Wyndham). No motels or motel lodges are acceptable. The presenter is then required to provide breakfast or disperse a per diem amount (\$20/person) for food on that day.

Food

Meals for the performers (9) and crew (5) are to be taken care of by the presenter. A typical meal schedule for show days is as follows:

- Side-stage Craft Services – A table should be set up at the venue with a variety of craft services snacks and beverages. Including one case of 24 bottled water and two cases if there is a signing/meet and greet. This should be available throughout the entirety of the day. Coffee, tea, and caffeine does not need to be available.
- Lunch – Upon arriving at the venue, a lunch should be provided for the crew and performers. Occasionally, the performers do not arrive until much later. In such cases, a lunch is only required for the crew.
- Dinner – A light dinner should be provided for the performers and crew. This dinner is usually served 2 hours prior to the beginning of the performance.

Dietary Restrictions

The members of Vocal Point have the following dietary restrictions:

- Heavy Dairy (e.g. milk, yogurt, cheesecake, etc.)
- Carbonated Drinks
- Please provide room temperature water rather than ice water
