- Young Ambassadors is a group of singers, dancers and musicians that has gained a reputation for excellent entertainment through energetic and heartwarming musical theater.
- The world-traveled Young Ambassadors perform nationally and internationally. In the past decade, the group has toured over 13 states and 15 countries, including Argentina, Australia, Brasil, China and Korea.
- In May 2019, the group toured China as a part of the BYU China Spectacular that included the following BYU groups: International Folk Dance Ensemble, Vocal Point, Living Legends, the Cougarettes, the Dunk Team and Chamber Orchestra.
- Community outreaches are integral to Young Ambassador tours. During their 2012 tour to South Africa, the group visited several orphanages, including the Sparrows Nest AIDS village.
- The Young Ambassadors traveled to the Nordic countries in May of 2009, visiting Denmark, Finland, Norway and Sweden. They performed 30 times in over a dozen venues. In February of 2009, the group also toured New Mexico and Texas.
- In 2002 the Young Ambassadors performed during the Winter Olympics in Salt Lake City, and took their production to Oregon, Washington, British Columbia and Alberta, Canada, receiving outstanding reviews
- The Young Ambassadors first performed internationally at Expo '70 in Osaka, Japan, and have since traveled throughout the United States and to 58 foreign countries. They were the first BYU performance group to entertain in Egypt, India, Morocco, Nepal, Sri Lanka, the People's Republic of China, Tunisia and Vietnam
- Randall Boothe has served as the group's director since 1977. Previously, Boothe was a director with Walt Disney Productions, Hawaii's Polynesian Cultural Center, Showcase Hawaii and the Polynesian Dance Ensemble.
- Young Ambassadors is produced by the School of Music, in cooperation with the Department of Dance, at Brigham Young University in Provo, Utah. BYU is one of the nation's largest private universities with an enrollment of more than 30,000 full-time students from throughout the United States as well as 100 foreign countries
