

Noteworthy, Brigham Young University's powerhouse women's a cappella group, has something for everyone, with a varied repertoire that includes pop, rock, jazz, hip-hop, and spiritual genres. In 2007 the group was crowned champion of the prestigious International Championship of Collegiate A Cappella, becoming only the second all-female ensemble to win the competition in more than 25 years. Noteworthy has since appeared on NBC's hit show *The Sing-Off*, released eight albums, and become a YouTube sensation with more than 120 million views and counting. Above all, Noteworthy strives to empower women and young people to discover their own unique identities and divine nature through the power of vocal music. The group originates in Brigham Young University's office of Performing Arts Management.




VOCAL POINT

Since its inception in 1991, Vocal Point, Brigham Young University's renowned men's a cappella group, has combined harmony, humor, and remarkable vocal percussion to deliver high-energy performances year in and year out. From national championships to national television, Vocal Point has captured the hearts of millions across the globe. In addition to winning the largest scholastic a cappella competition in the world, the group had a magical run in 2011 on NBC's competition *The Sing-Off*. Since then, Vocal Point's online popularity has exploded—racking up more than 190 million views on the group's YouTube channel. Additionally, the group has won dozens of Contemporary A Cappella Recording Awards. In 2019, Vocal Point became one of only a few a cappella groups to sign a major record contract when they signed with Universal Music Group.
