Provo, Utah, 2026 – Since first sharing the stage, Brigham Young University Noteworthy and Vocal Point have brought exceptional a cappella showmanship to stages around the world. They began their 2025-2026 season with a mid-semester tour to China, where they joined the BYU Ballroom Dance Company and Young Ambassadors as participants in the Shanghai International Arts Festival.

Through the winter semester, the ensembles kept busy with regional performances in Idaho, Nevada, and Utah and rounded out the holiday season as featured artists on the *In Good Faith* podcast in a special Christmas episode. With every performance, the ensembles strive not only to entertain but to leave a lasting positive impact. Whether performing for a classroom of high school students or a venue full of strangers, Vocal Point and Noteworthy deliver more than just a show. They create an experience that resonates long after the final note.



In May, the groups took their show on tour across the US Midwest and Northeast, performing, leading school music workshops, and meeting with local Church members. In addition to performances, outreach, and service opportunities, the groups took the

opportunity to visit many historic sites, where they deepened their appreciation for their country and heritage.

In the coming 2026-2027 season, Noteworthy and Vocal Point will continue to excite and inspire audiences, starting with a mid-semester tour to Southern California and performances throughout the Wasatch Front. In April, the ensembles will embark on an international tour to the Philippines, Guam, and Mongolia. Upon returning from their extended tour, they'll finish out the season performing at the Salt Lake City Temple open house celebration.
