The Brigham Young University Men's Chorus, founded in 1901 as the Male Glee, is believed to be the largest collegiate male choral organization in the country. What began with humble roots has grown into a distinguished 180-voice ensemble known for its versatility and engaging performance style. The choir represents a diverse cross-section of the university, with members from across the U.S. and around the world, most of whom are not music majors. Through dedicated rehearsal and a powerful, unified sound, the Men's Chorus delivers dynamic performances featuring a wide-ranging repertoire that appeals to audiences of all ages.

Honors

- In 2024, the choir released their latest EP, "He Sent His Son," featuring four Christ-centric tracks that resonate with themes of faith, strength, and the redemptive power of Jesus Christ.
- BYU Men's Chorus joined BYU Vocal Point in their moving rendition of "Nearer, My God, to Thee," which has captivated audiences and accumulated over 39 million views on YouTube.
- The choir released its first free album in the spring of 2013, "Set Apart," which features well-known missionary hymns.
