Honors

- In 2022, jazz legend Wynton Marsalis personally invited the group to perform at the prestigious Jack Rudin Jazz Championship, where they earned accolades for Best Trombone Section, Best Trumpet Section, and multiple Outstanding Soloist awards across the ensemble.
- In 2016, the group went on an extended tour to the Baltic States, covering Estonia, Latvia Lithuania, Sweden and Finland. On tour, the group made history at the Saulkrasti Jazz Festival by playing multiple encores.


As BYU's premier big band, Synthesis is equipped to:
