- Brigham Young University Singers is an exciting choral ensemble that performs music from a variety of periods and styles. From a Renaissance motet to an African-American spiritual, the group performs pieces from nearly every musical genre as well as many original works written or arranged for the choir.
- BYU Singers has performed in some of the most prestigious concert halls in the world, including Carnegie Hall in New York City; the Kennedy Center in Washington, D.C.; the Sydney Opera House and Town Hall in Sydney, Australia; the Kapella in St. Petersburg; the Musikverein in Vienna; and the Walt Disney Concert Hall in Los Angeles.
- The choral ensemble will take their talents to Northern California and Nevada in May 2019.
- BYU Singers were featured at the 2017 biennial conference of the National Collegiate Choral Organization (NCCO) in Baton Rouge, Louisiana. In 2006, they sang at NCCO's inaugural conference.
- The choir most recently completed a tour to Vietnam and Indonesia in 2018. During this tour, the group performed in many different cities and worked with numerous universities and community choirs, giving workshops and collaborating in joint performances.
- BYU Singers has traveled within the United States and to 29 countries including Russia, Germany, Switzerland, Italy, England, Egypt, Australia, Ghana, Ireland, South Africa, and China.
- In 2009, the choir participated in the Cork International Choral Festival in Ireland, where they received the Audience Favorite Award, sponsored by the P.E.A.C.E. organization.
- The choir, by invitation, has performed three separate concerts with the Israeli Chamber Orchestra in Israel.
- Also by invitation, BYU Singers has performed numerous times at regional and national conferences of the American Choral Directors Association. Most recently, they appeared at the 2019 ACDA national conference in Kansas City.
- The group was one of two choirs chosen to represent the United States at the Fourth World Symposium on Choral Music in Sydney, Australia, and also represented the U.S. by singing at the 2002 Winter Olympics in Salt Lake City.
- Director of the choir, Dr. Andrew Crane, is a graduate of BYU and took the helm of this performing group at the start of the 2015 season. Past positions include Director of Choral Activities at East Carolina University and at California State University, San Bernardino. Choirs under his direction have appeared by invitation at multiple conferences of the American Choral Directors Association, National Collegiate Choral Organization, and National Association for Music Education; and have won top prizes in international competitions.
