Vocal Point’s popularity has exploded in recent years. In 2006 the group took home the title of International Champions of College A Cappella, and the following year were voted the nation’s favorite male collegiate a cappella group by the Contemporary A Cappella Society of America. The group finished in the top 5 of NBC’s “The Sing-Off” in 2011 and won an Emmy award for their music video “Tarzan in the Museum” in 2021.
