Comprised of more than 180 members, the Women's Chorus is one of four prestigious choirs at Brigham Young University. With auditions held annually, the ensemble honors the female voice by showcasing their incredibly focused technique and well-rehearsed sound. Under the direction of Dr. Sonja Poulter, the choir garners domestic and international acclaim with their diverse repertoire, harmonious blend of voices, and depth of sound. Their empowerment of the divine attributes of women alongside the skillful creation of music encourages both the singers and audience members to engage in peace-finding and faith-promoting experiences.

Honors

- BYU Women's Chorus is held in very high esteem as they have been featured, on multiple occasions, in the American Choral Directors Association, a national group that holds conventions both regionally and nationally each year.
- In 2024, the choir performed at multiple venues across Switzerland and also Germany on their first ever international tour. They held four concerts, performed as the featured artist at multiple festivals and sang at a devotional for youth in the Frankfurt area.
