ACTIVITY	SET UP	LENGTH	REQUIREMENTS	NOTES
Rest home/ Care Center/ Hospital/ Orphanage	5 minutes	20-30 minutes	Piano; residents in a day room or cafeteria; access to electricity (wall plug)	Content: Selections from the show & the group's fireside programs which appeal to the audience; can end with visits to rooms and in ICUs.
Radio Interview	5 minutes	as requested	Group will bring recordings of music to play	Content: Experienced group members & directors will be available for live interviews.
Vocal Workshop (1 sessions only)	5 minutes	40-50 minutes	Piano; microphone if the group is large	Content: Vocal material only, including review of vocal techniques & class participation.
3 Session Workshop (vocal, dance, and acting emphasis)	10 minutes	90 minutes (20 minutes session and breaks between)	3 rooms for the sessions: Vocal room with piano, large dance room w/o chair, and acting open room with chairs around outside.	Content: Featuring vocal, dance, and acting techniques with class participation. Please dress accordingly to dance activities.
Show Band Workshop (works well with 3 session workshop)	10 minutes	50-90 minutes	1 room with access to: drum kit, pianos, and/or 2 keyboards, any available amps for electric guitar, bass, and virtual percussion.	Content: Coaching, demos, exploring different styles of music, technical mastery, personal improvement, auditions.
Workshop for Performing Arts Students	10 minutes	2 hours maximum	Piano; access to electricity; 1 large room *No more than 40 students total	Content: Covers American musical theater by teaching one-on-one; hands-on experience with participants acting in musical theater parts.
Visit to Mayor or Community Leader	5 minutes	5-10 minutes	None	Content: Group will sing 1 song & present a gift of memento from BYU

Television Interview/ Presentation	30 minutes if in costume	as requested	Depends on what is requested for content of the event	Content: Interviews and/or performance elements as requested; video shorts will be available.
School Lecture/ Demonstration	5 minutes	30 minutes	Access to electricity; room small enough to communicate without microphones. *No more than 300 students	Content: Cast members sing songs and dance numbers from the group's show without costumes or props
Youth Conference	10 minutes	2- 2.5 hours	Open space for instruction and discussion in 3-4 separate rooms; access to electricity & a piano	Content: Fireside and workshop elements (relating to Christ-like attributes) following a suggested community service activity.
Fireside/ Morningside	60 minutes	60 minutes	The opening music, hymn, prayer, & person to conduct should be provided locally.	Content: Songs & short talks regarding love of family, scriptures & the Savior.
